

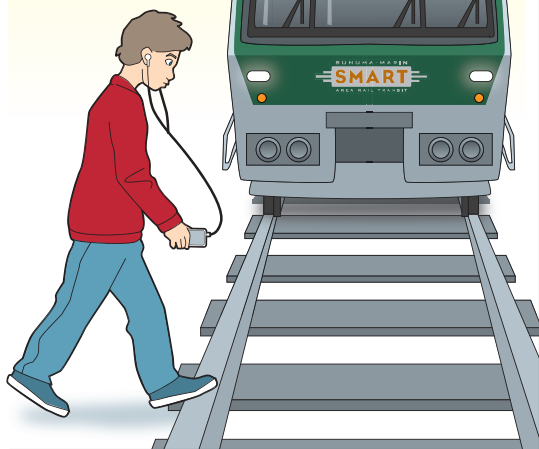
Remember to tell your family and friends how to be safe around railroad tracks: You could save a life!

The railroad track in Sonoma and Marin Counties is now an active railroad. Do you know the Rail Safety Rules?



HEADPHONE ALERT:

Wearing headphones or ear buds around tracks prevents you from hearing warning bells! By the time a train operator sees you on the tracks, it is too late to stop the train in time to avoid hitting you!



Important safety rule: Write the letters found along the correct path to the sidewalk on the lines below.

At all rail crossings:

Three sets of horizontal lines for writing the letters found along the correct path.

Safety-Minded Around Rails and Trains

ALWAYS / NEVER walk on or next to the tracks.

ALWAYS / NEVER cross tracks when bells are ringing, lights are flashing and the gate is lowered!

Circle NEVER or ALWAYS to complete these safety rules.

ALWAYS / NEVER take a "shortcut" to cross the tracks.

ALWAYS / NEVER cross tracks at a crossbuck.
