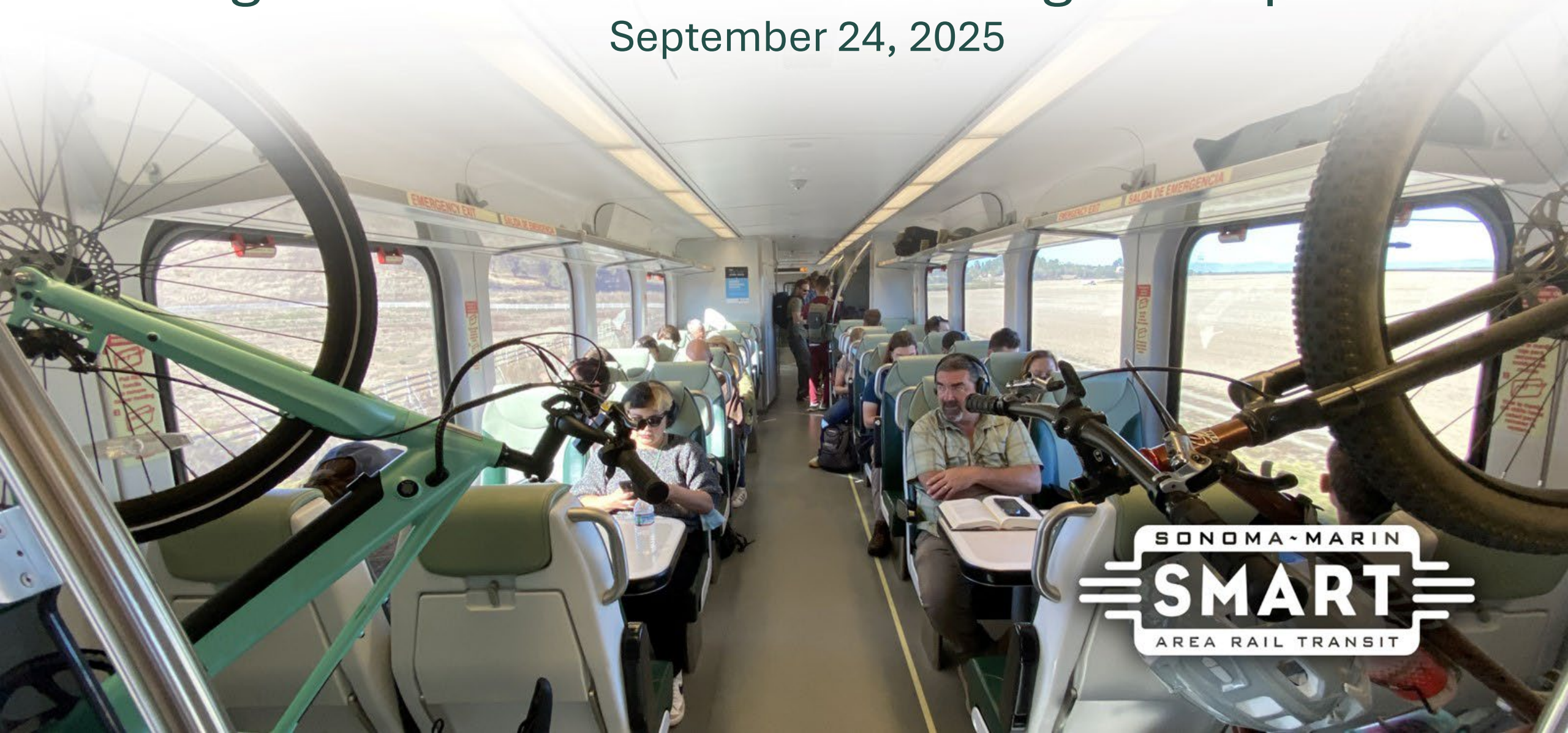

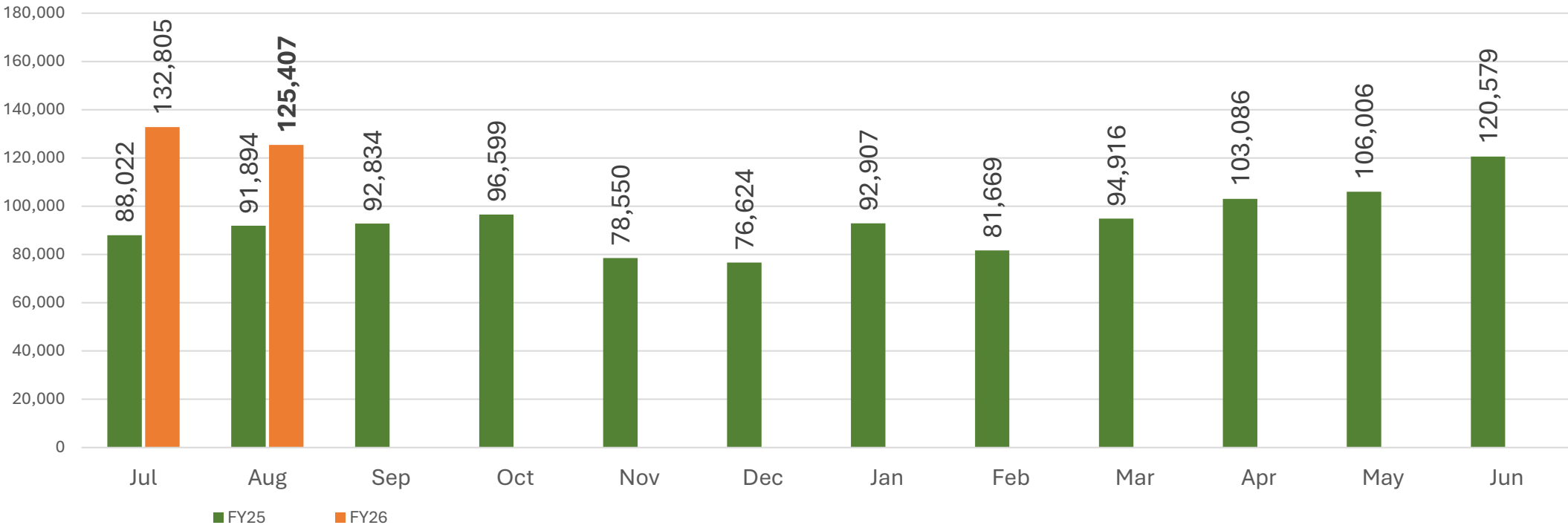

SMART Ridership (Monthly)

August ridership = 125,407

- 27% higher than August 2024
- 5th straight month over 100K



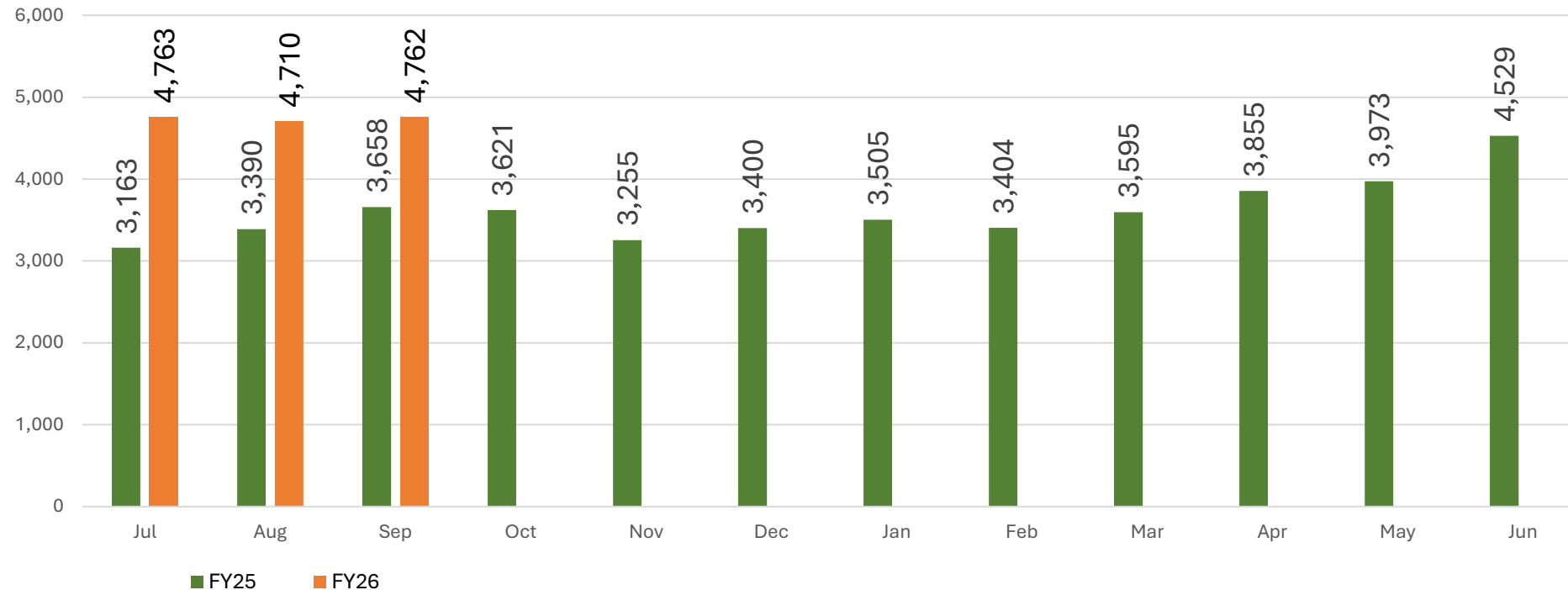
Average Weekday Ridership

August Average Weekday ridership: 4,710

- 39% over August 2024

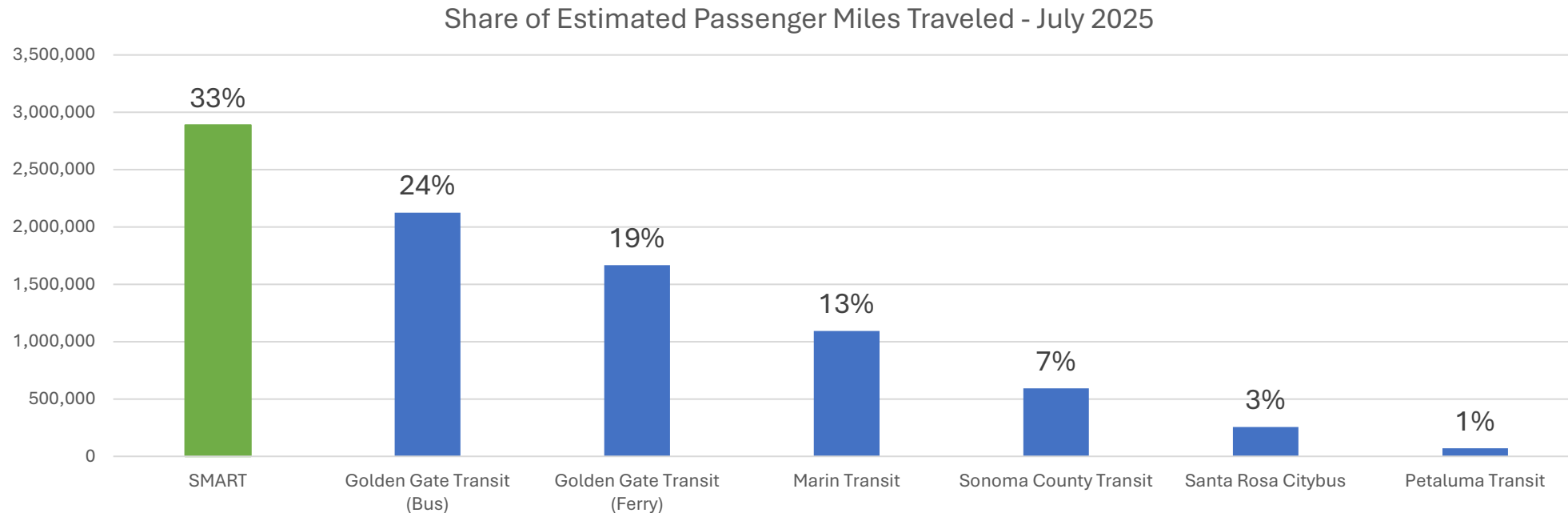
September Average Weekday ridership to date: 4,762

- 30% over September 2024



Passenger Miles Traveled (July)

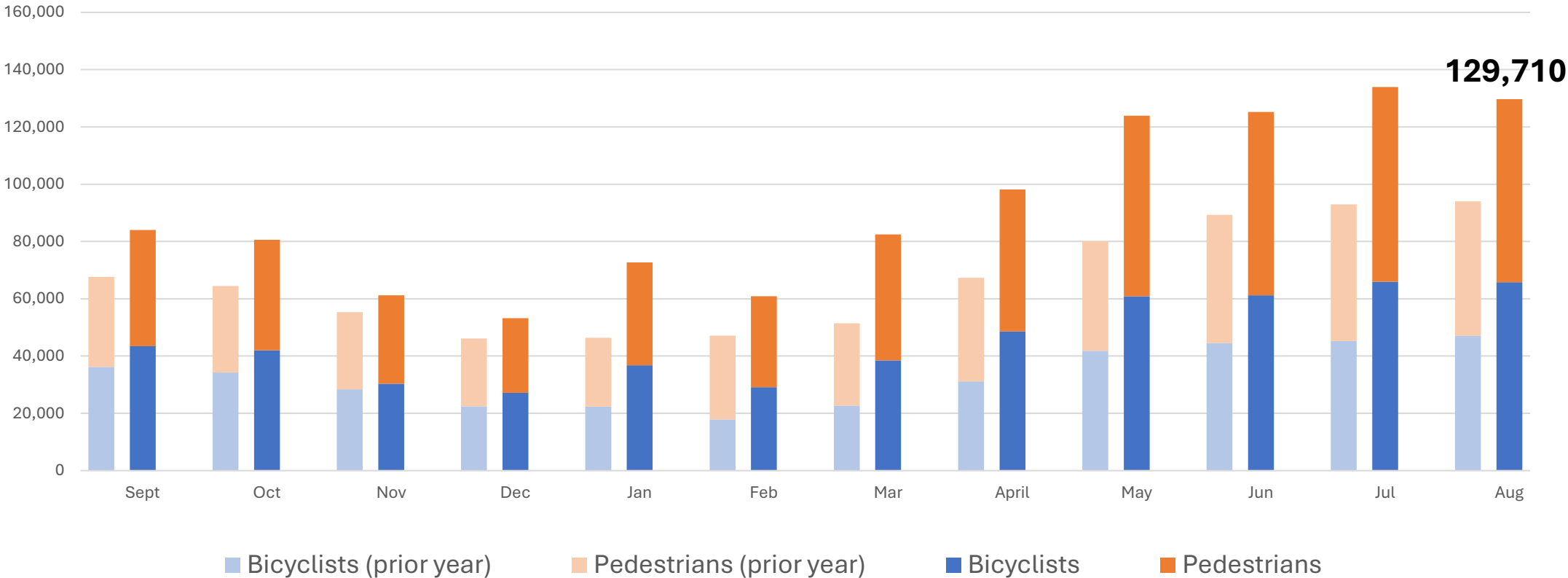
- SMART carried 2.9 Million passenger miles in July
 - 33% of total
 - Highest among Marin/Sonoma Operators



SMART Pathway Counts

August Pathway Trips = 129,710

- 38% higher than August 2024



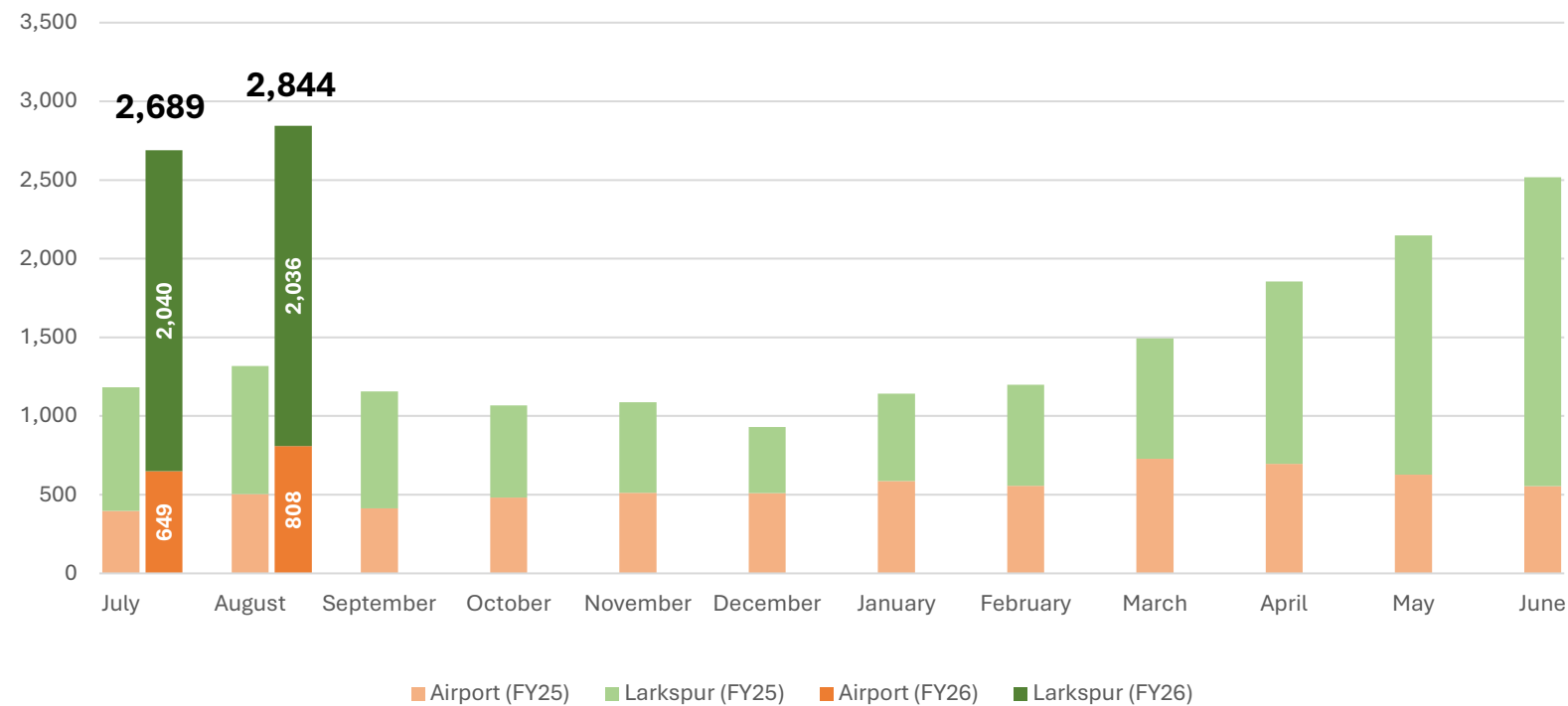
SMART Connect Ridership

- New monthly record for both shuttles!

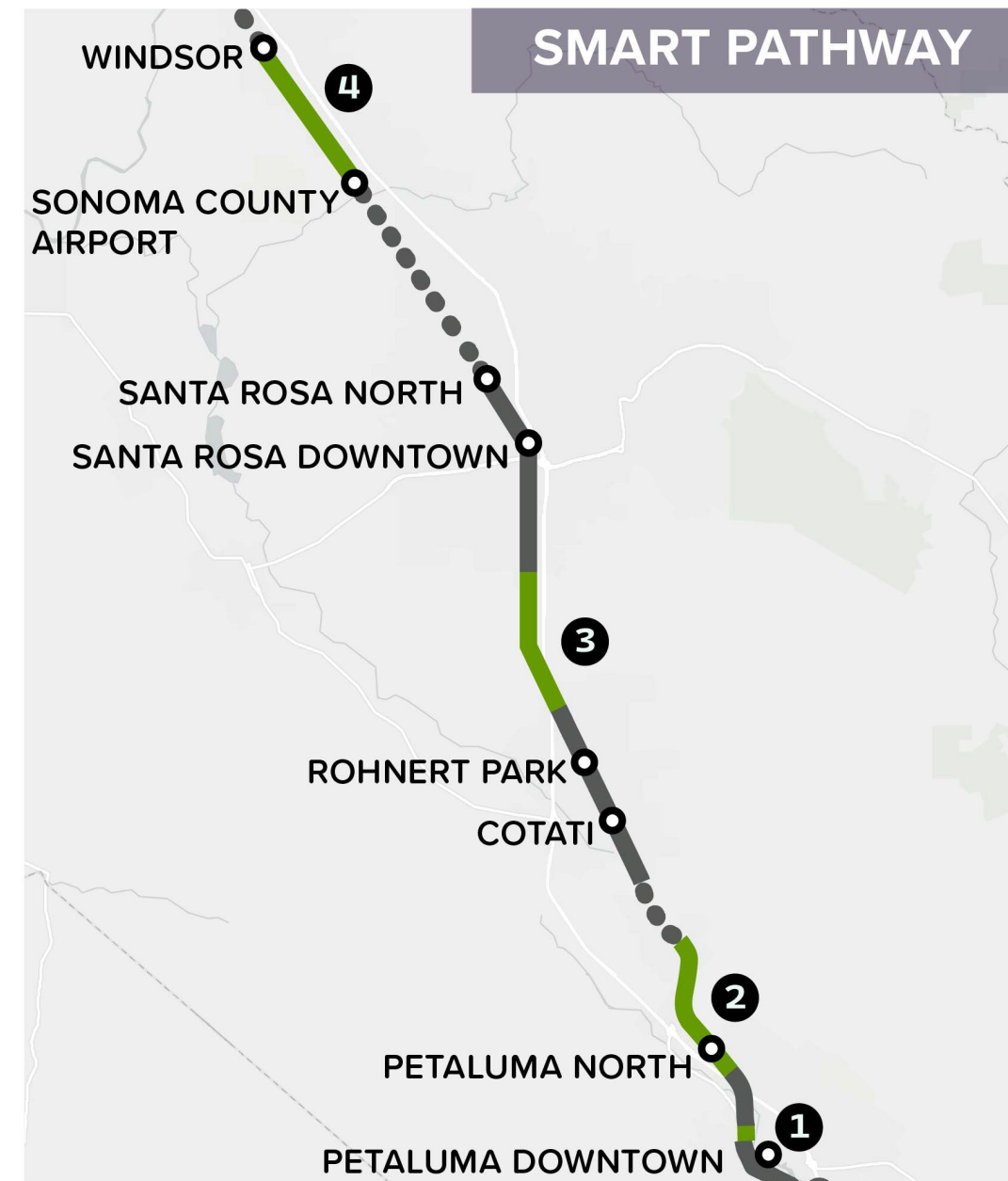


SMART Connect Ridership (FY25-FY26)



Resolution of Necessity

- SMART Board of Director approved a Resolution of Necessity on 9/17/25
- Authorized staff to proceed with actions necessary to acquire pathway easements
- Affected sections
 1. Lakeville to Payran Street
 2. Southpoint Blvd. to Main Street
 3. Golf Course Dr. to Bellevue Ave.
 4. Airport Blvd. to Windsor River Rd.
- Next Steps:
 - Proceed with quiet title action
 - File eminent domain for pathway easements

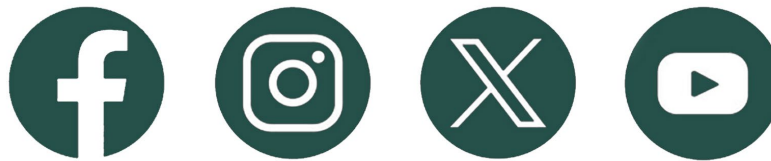
