
#### **TSA Mask Directive**

- Guidance indicates CDC will work with government agencies to help inform a revised policy framework for when, and under what circumstances, masks should be required in the public transportation corridor
- This revised framework will be based on the COVID-19 community levels, risk of new variants, national data, and the latest science.




### **Trending Ridership**

Average Weekday & Saturday Ridership




 Average daily ridership fell in December and January due to Omicron but rebounded in February and March.

#### **Percentage of Riders Bringing Bikes on Board**








Sept-Dec 2019 vs. 2021 Parking Usage
