Budget Amendment #2 – Project Funding Roll Forwards

- Pathway: Golf Course to Bellevue and Southpoint to Penngrove
 - Required for remaining close-out items in FY26
 - Shift \$99,429 of ATP funds from FY25 to FY26
 - Shift \$50,000 Measure Q Sales Tax funding from FY25 to FY26
 - Expense side: budget \$149,429
- State of Good Repair : McDowell Grade Crossing
 - Remaining items rolling to FY26
 - \$50,000 of Measure Q Sales Tax funds
 - Expense side: budget \$50,000 in FY26
- Station: Petaluma North
 - Punchlist items completing in FY26
 - Shift \$150,000 Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Improvement (TIRCP) funds into FY26
 - Budget \$150,000 in expenses



Budget Amendment #2 – Project Funding Roll Forwards (continued)

- Extension: Windsor Systems
 - Completing final elements of the systems portion of the project in FY26
 - Shifting \$200,000 in Measure Q Sales Tax funding into FY26
 - Budgeting \$200,000 of expense previously budgeted in FY25 into FY26
- Development: Healdsburg Extension Progressive Design-Build
 - Funds for the continuation of the project for preliminary design and permitting costs
 - Rolling the remaining \$97,144 of funds from the Community Project Funds Discretionary Earmark into FY26
 - Truing up and reducing the revenue from the Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Improvement Program (TIRCP) by \$113,680 in FY26
 - Reducing the overall budgeted amount for this project by \$16,536 to match remaining grant funding
 - Shifting \$2,625,000 initially budgeted in FY26 to Capital facilities projects to Non-Capital projects to fund the preliminary stage of the project and prepare for the Progressive Design-Build process



Budget Amendment #2 – Project Funding Roll Forwards (continued)

- Pathway: Joe Rodota Trail
 - Shift \$1,768 of Measure Q funds to finish up design work in FY26
 - Budget \$1,768 of expenses in FY26
- Work for Others: Joe Rodota to Third Street Traffic Signal
 - Roll \$31,136 of funding from the City of Santa Rosa for design of the traffic signal into FY26
 - Increase the expense budget by \$31,136 in FY26
- Pathway: Puerto Suello Tunnel
 - Shift \$119,184 of Measure Q funding for the design into FY26
 - Budget an additional \$119,184 in FY26
- Pathway: Guerneville Rd to Airport Blvd Permitting
 - Shift \$5,005 of Measure Q funding into FY26
 - Roll \$5,005 of expenses into FY26

Budget Amendment #2 – Additional Changes

MASCOTS

- Additional \$200,000 in funding through the State Transit Assistance (STA) allocation
- Previous \$600,000 awarded will come through STA allocation as well, not MTC as was initially budgeted
- Total MASCOTS funding of \$800,000 in FY26

STA Funds

- To match an updated forecast, we are reducing the STA population grant funds by \$42,817 for total of \$1,266,953
- Freight Budget Bridge Projects
 - Previously rolled \$475,301into FY26 as part of initial budget
 - Project construction costs estimated at \$679,658
 - Requires additional \$204,358 funding and expense
 - Adding \$102,179 of funds from the Short Line Rail Improvement Program (SLRIP), matched with \$102,179 of already budgeted internal funds from Freight Movement Fees
 - To account for \$102,179 funding now spent on the Bridge Projects, backfilling the Freight Fund with \$102,179 from the California Priority Legislative Budget Projects 2024 Grant
