


SMART Ridership (Monthly)

October ridership = 120,127

- 24% higher than Oct 2024
- 110% higher than Oct 2019 (pre-COVID)

7th straight month over 100k






Average Weekday Ridership

• 30% over Nov 2024






SMART Connect Ridership

• 50% increase at Airport over last October














SMART Pathway Counts

MASCOTS Update

- SMART Board approved new positions associated with MASCOTS service increase in July 2025
 - Currently hiring/training 13 new employees
- Golden Gate and Marin Transit Boards recently approved service changes
- SMART service will be implemented in April 2026
 - 19% increase is SMART service
 - Increase weekday service from 42 to 48 trips
 - Increase weekend service from 16 to 24 trips
 - Includes evening service until 11pm weekdays & weekends
