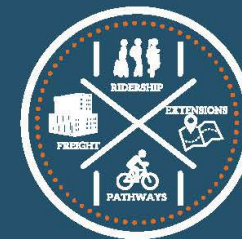
Strategic Plan Alignment

“complete system extensions to Cloverdale”

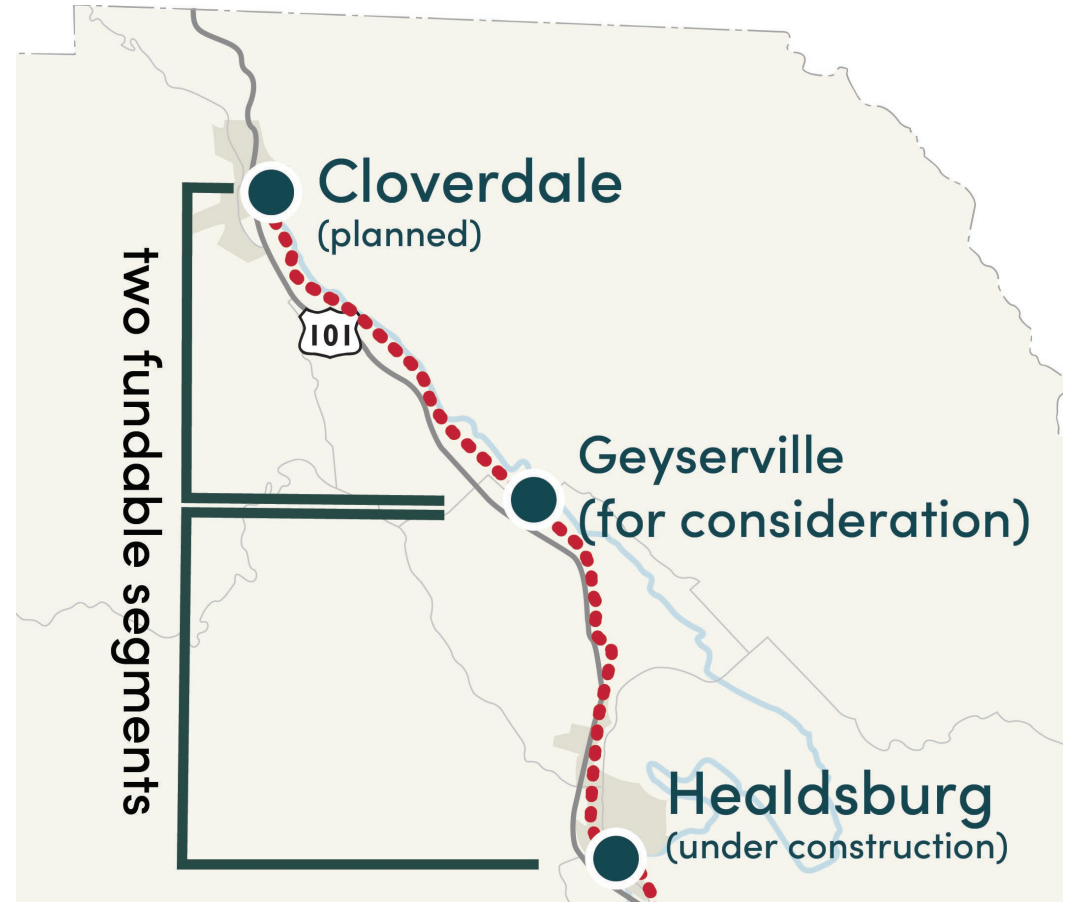
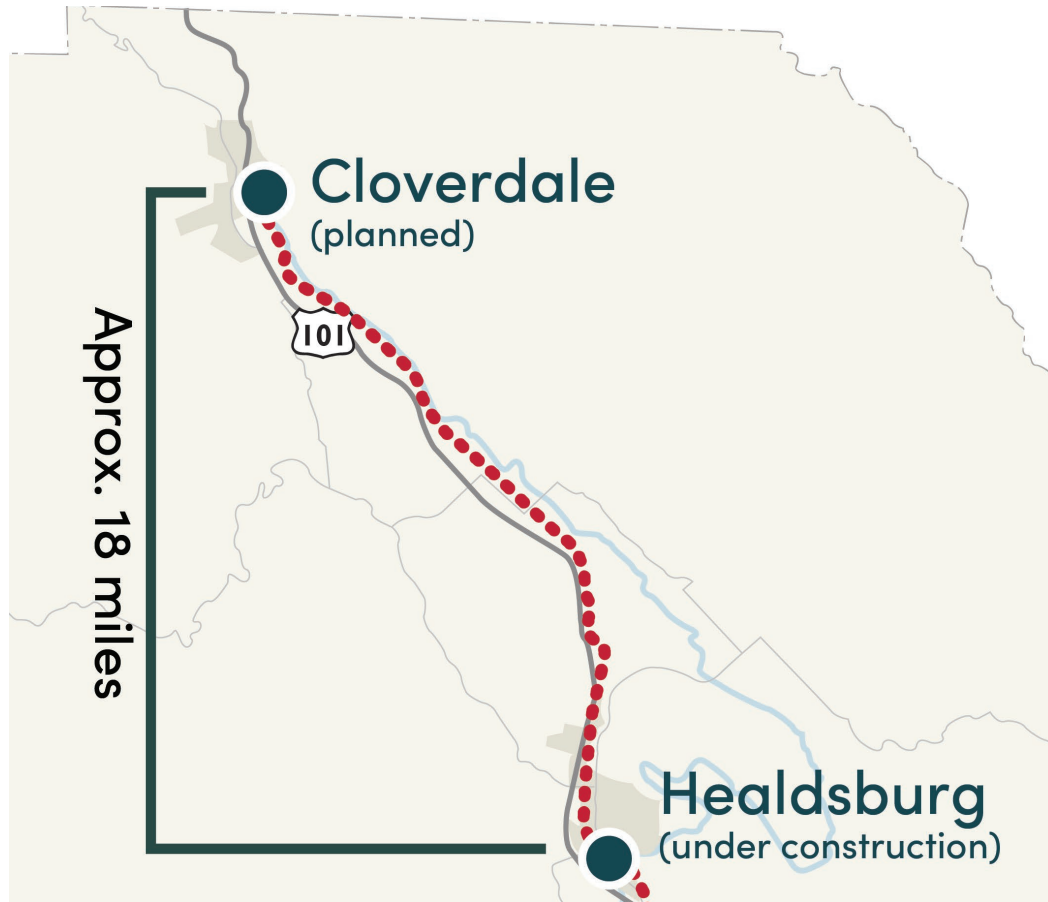
and

Strategic Segmentation



Opportunity

- To segment the delivery of the 18-mile extension
- To improve the utility of the system without harming railroad operations
- To locate a station in Geyserville that would:
 - Be built within SMART's existing right of way
 - Facilitate public and private 1st/last mile bus connectivity
 - Be within the urban service area, and
 - Be located in close proximity to the highest job concentration in the central Alexander Valley/Geyserville area

Legislation Now Makes a Station Possible

- 2024 Senate Bill 904 (SB904) by Senator Dodd updated SMART's enabling legislation to allow for the construction of a SMART station between Healdsburg and Cloverdale.



Recommendation

- Seeking Board direction to engage the public on the inclusion of a proposed Geyserville Station into the SMART system.
- Next Steps:
 - June/July 2026 — Geyserville Alexander Valley Municipal Advisory Council (GAV-MAC) and Planning Committee Meetings
 - August 2026 — SMART-hosted workshop in Geyserville/Alexander Valley
 - Summer 2026 — public survey
