## Make a Triple Play taking the train & ferry to Giants games!



North Bay Giants fans can enjoy a smooth, car-free trip to Oracle Park by taking SMART to Larkspur and connecting to the Giants Ferry. The Giants Ferry arrives at the Oracle Park landing, bringing passengers just steps from the stadium entrance—no traffic, no parking hassles, just easy game-day travel.

The schedule below lists [Giants games](#) with both train and [Giants Ferry](#) service. Golden Gate's Giants Ferry operates for all home games. Fans can also take SMART and connect to the [regular Larkspur Ferry service](#) to the San Francisco Ferry Building, which is a 25-minute (1.2-mile) walk or a 15-minute transit ride on [Muni transit](#) from Oracle Park. Both ferry connections are shown below.

## SMART Train Tickets

**Youth and Seniors Ride Free** - Youth ages 0-18 and seniors ages 65 and older ride FREE on SMART.

**Rail and Sail Combo Ticket** - The \$10 Sail and Rail combo ticket is **not available** for connections to the Giants Ferry. However it may be used for the regular Larkspur Ferry which travels from Larkspur to the San Francisco Ferry Building, which is a 25-minute walk (1.2-mile) or a 15-minute [Muni transit](#) ride from Oracle Park. Tickets for the Giants Ferry are sold separately (see below).

**Weekend Day Pass** - SMART's Weekend Day Pass is ideal for passengers traveling to Giants games on Saturdays or Sundays. This pass offers unlimited train rides for one weekend day, and cost is \$10 for adults and \$5 persons with disabilities. The weekend pass is exclusively available for purchase on the SMART [eTickets App](#).

**SMART Fares** - Train fare is \$1.50 for each zone traveled. Persons with disabilities or with a low income pay a discount fare of \$0.75 per zone traveled. For example, a trip from the Sonoma County Airport station to the Larkspur station is 5 zones traveled and would be a fare of \$7.50.

**SMART eTickets Mobile App** - SMART's [eTickets App](#) is ideal when purchasing train tickets for multiple people. Discount fares for persons with disabilities are available on the SMART eTickets App. Download the free app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store by searching for SMART eTickets.

**Clipper Card** - SMART accepts Clipper, the same payment system used by other Bay Area transit providers.

## Giants Ferry Tickets

Golden Gate's special [Giants Ferry](#) serves all [Giants home games](#), including evening games, but only connects with SMART trains for day games. Tickets for the Giants Ferry must be purchased online in advance—they are not sold at ferry terminals and are non-refundable and non-exchangeable. Clipper Card fare payment (mobile app or card) is not accepted.

The ferry departs from Larkspur Ferry Terminal and travels directly to Oracle Park. On the return trip, the ferry departs 30 minutes after the game or after programmed events such as fireworks have concluded.

## Trip Planning Information

**Walk or ride to the ferry terminal** - The Larkspur Ferry Terminal is a short 12 minute walk from the Larkspur station. Alternatively, the SMART [Connect Larkspur shuttle](#) provides a convenient link between the SMART Larkspur station and the Larkspur Ferry Terminal. The bright orange shuttle meets every southbound train within 10 minutes, with reservations recommended via the [Ride Pingo App](#) or by calling 800-727-0279, though walk-ons are welcome if space allows.

**Accessibility** - SMART and Golden Gate ferries are accessible to all passengers. Trains, platforms, and fare machines are accessible. Train doors marked with an accessibility icon indicate the closest accessible seating.

**Bicycles** - Bikes are welcome on board the trains and ferries. Trains and ferries are equipped with racks to hang bicycles. All SMART stations have bicycle parking, including secured bike lockers provided by [BikeLink](#).

**Parking** - FREE parking is available at the following SMART stations: Windsor (*opening in late May*), Sonoma County Airport, Rohnert Park, Cotati, Petaluma Downtown, Petaluma North, Novato San Marin, Novato Downtown, Novato Hamilton, and Larkspur.
